CourtSolutions currently services many federal bankruptcy courts, including courts overseeing some of the largest bankruptcy proceedings, such as the Puerto Rico, Toys “R” Us, and Payless Shoes matters. Through its website, CourtSolutions offers participants access to the Hearing Dashboard, which provides a visual representation of the call, real-time information about who is speaking, the ability to “raise your hand” to be recognized by the court, and various means for the court to control the call. You can join a call from any phone after chambers approves your reservation request.

Anyone who wishes to attend this hearing telephonically must visit www.Court-Solutions.com to request to participate. If you do not have an account, you can create one by clicking “Sign Up.” Once you have an account, log in and submit a reservation request. Once approved by chambers, you will be able to participate. Members of the public or the press can sign up and participate on a listen-only basis.
